



The Deer Park-Silverton Joint Fire District is accepting applications to identify a candidate for the for the position of **Full-Time Lieutenant Firefighter/Paramedic**.

Applications are available upon email request to c.iredale@dpsjfd.org, downloaded from www.dpsjfd.org, or they can be picked up at the Deer Park-Silverton Joint Fire District administration offices located at 7050 Blue Ash Road, Cincinnati, Ohio 45236, during normal business hours (Mon-Fri, 8am-4pm).

Applications should be filled out completely to include any identified supplemental information. Completed applications along with a resume must be received by 4:00 pm Eastern Standard Time, on Tuesday December 28, 2020. Submittal of applications can be via e-mail, US Postal Service (or equivalent), or in person at 7050 Blue Ash Road, Cincinnati, Ohio 45236. The following **minimum** requirements must be met for eligibility:

- Have at least five (5) years of full-time Fire or EMS service experience
- Ohio Certified Firefighter II
- Ohio Certified Paramedic
- Current CPR and ACLS certifications
- Possess a high school diploma or GED certificate
- Possess a valid driver's license

Hiring Process

Application and Resume Submission

Candidates who meet all requirements will have their resumes reviewed by a committee of Deer Park-Silverton Joint Fire District officers. Based upon the qualifications of the applicants, the committee will select five (5) potential candidates to be interviewed by a community panel.

Community Panel Interview

Five (5) applicants will sit for a community panel interview. The panel will be appointed by the mayors of Deer Park and Silverton, and will consist of two residents from each community. The community panel will provide their insights to the Fire Chief to assist in the selection of the candidate that best fills the needs of the Fire District and communities we serve.

Medical Evaluation and Drug Screen

A pension physical and drug screen for the applicant determined to be the best candidate for the Fire District will be required after an employment offer is tendered.

Compensation and Benefits

The starting annual salary range for this position is \$26.54 to \$27.89 per hour, based on previous full-time experience and qualifications. Salary may escalate in subsequent years, subject to the Collective Bargaining Agreement.

Shift will be an assigned 24/48 (unit day) rotation, with a Kelly day every 21 days.

Lateral benefits to be considered based upon experience and qualifications.
